

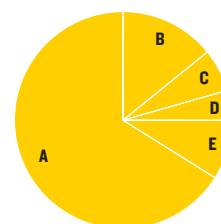

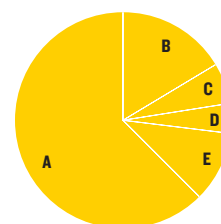
Funding Allocations

The research grant program makes up most of the annual budget for ABMRF/The Foundation for Alcohol Research, with conference support, communications and publishing activities, and administration accounting for the remainder. In 2009, the Foundation was able to fund 17 new grant projects and 11 continuation grants from a total of 125 applications submitted. The vast majority of these grants were awarded to principal investigators who are working at the level of instructor or assistant professor and so are at the beginning of their careers in alcohol research.

Grants and Conference Support

ABMRF/The Foundation for Alcohol Research proudly continued its support of the Research Society on Alcoholism (RSA) Annual Meeting, which is the largest North American alcohol research conference, by providing financial support for plenary speakers and also for Student Merit and Junior Investigator Awards. These awards enable the newest members of RSA to attend this important event. The 32nd Annual RSA Scientific Meeting was held June 20 through 24 in San Diego, California.

The Foundation provided support for the inauguration of the Centre for Responsible Drinking in Ottawa, Ontario, Canada on October 1. Support was also given for the 5th Symposium on Exploring US/French Collaborations in Alcohol Abuse and Alcoholism Research held on October 9 in Rockville, Maryland.
